WE THE COUNCIL OF BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS Chief and Council approve the recommendation to suspend current job descriptions for non-essential employees. Non-essential employees will therefore have the option to be reassigned for duties as deemed essential by the Emergency Control Group until the COVID-19 Pandemic is declared over or have the option to take voluntary lay-off, effective Monday, April 6th 2020.

WHEREAS Chief and Council approve the Beausoleil First Nation Territory Residency List as of April 6th, 2020. Furthermore, any additions will require council approval.

WHEREAS Chief and Council approve the recommendation to implement screening and security protocols for any travel to a high-risk area such as a hospital, nursing home, long-term care facility or any private residence where an occupant has been tested or awaiting test results for COVID-19 or has had an overnight stay would need to adhere the protocols as issued by the designated Beausoleil Family Health Centre Nurse\Nurse Practitioner. Furthermore, the protocols have been identified as self-monitoring, self-isolation and isolation for all residents of the household.

WHEREAS Chief and Council approve the recommendation to implement the following protocols relating travelling:

Cedar Point Security & Screening Process, as per Sec. 20 and 21 of the Federal Marine Transportation Security Act will be in effect as of Monday, April 6th, 2020.

The new travel allowance of two persons, per household, per week and maximum vehicle occupancy of 2 persons will be in effect until the COVID-19 Pandemic is declared over. **No other person(s) from separate households will be permitted to travel.**

Any conflicts or issues relating to the restrictions would be referred to ecgquestions@chimnissing.ca to appeal for an exemption which include:

ALLOWANCES & EXEMPTIONS

Medical reasons, seniors requiring assistance shopping and disabled members that require assistance shopping. Two members from the same household to complete shopping but only for shopping for themselves and other identified island residents with the understanding that both households will be relinquishing their weekly shopping trip for identified households.

Parents with infant or infants aged 0-18 months where the parent does not have the option to travel without the infant(s) is not available.

Any travel that results in an absence exceeding 24-hours from Christian Island will result in a mandatory 14 day self-isolation. Pre-approval from ECG is required with an adequate self-isolation plan. Noncompliance means they do not board.

WEHEREAS to ensure the health and safety of the community, any and all individual requests must be forwarded to ecgquestions@chimnissing.ca for approval by the ECG.

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED Chief and Council approve the recommendations and protocols identified above.
