BFN COVID-19 Response Plan

Level 6 Lockdown

- Transportation limited to Essential Services (APS, EMS & EOT) and Essential Employment with verification from Employer.
- Residents with medical needs from mainland health service providers will be temporarily housed on the mainland.
- Emergency Food Supply available for all Cedar Point and Christian Island Residents.

Level 5 Highest Restrictions

- Travel Restrictions - 1 household trip per week, 2 per vehicle and 2 runs for essential services, shopping, medical and harm reduction only - possible full shutdown/lockdown dependent on current state of pandemic. **PASSENGER AND VEHICLES FARES SUSPENDED**
- Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.
- Access to BFN Territory restricted to year-round residents (includes students attending Post-Secondary who would normally reside on Christian Island when not in attendance at college or university) as per approved residency list.
- Indoor/outdoor construction permitted for emergency situations that pose a health and safety risk.
- No special travel requests, only authorized "movement".
- All non-essential band business suspended (reduction of hours, reallocation of staff, etc).
- Self-Monitor, Self-Isolation and Isolation Protocols implemented as per Ontario Public Health (OPH).
- Emergency Food Supply available for all Cedar Point and Christian Island Residents.
- Delivery companies restricted to those on the approved list as identified by the Emergency Operations Team.
- Initiate application for emergency child care for health care and other frontline workers. Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.

Level 4 Many Restrictions

- Travel Restrictions: 2 household trips per week, 3 per vehicle (same household) and 6 ferry runs. **PASSENGER AND VEHICLES FARES SUSPENDED**
- Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.
- Self-Monitor, Self-Isolation and Isolation Protocols implemented as per Ontario Public Health.
- All non-essential band business suspended (reduction of hours, reallocation of staff, etc.)
- No indoor gatherings or residential visits indoors are permitted as per OPH
- No in-person education. Essential businesses will be open with limited capacity, masks are required.
- Outdoor recreation facilities remain closed, including, beaches, campgrounds, parks and playgrounds.
- Outdoor construction is permitted, adhering to physical and social distancing protocols.
- Indoor construction is permitted for vacant units, adhering to physical and social distancing protocols.
- Emergency Food Supply available to all Cedar Point and Christian Island households in isolation.
- Food Security available on a maintenance schedule to stock emergency supplies.
- Delivery Companies restricted to those on the approved list as identified by the Emergency Operations Team.

Level 3 Moderate Restrictions

- No travel restrictions but there is a **TRAVEL ADVISORY** to hotspots identified by OPH (Toronto, York, Peel, Ottawa). Please refer to the **WELL-BEING PROTOCOL**. Current ferry schedule in service with passenger and vehicle fares.
- Conditional Agreement in place for **non-resident members** and immediate family (as per BFN P&P) visiting residents. All protocols currently in place must be followed. Masks are **MANDATORY** in all indoor settings.
- Boyfriend/girlfriend, fiancé/ee will no longer be allowed to visit BFN territory.
- Chimnissing Transit on Level 3 schedule with physical distancing protocols in place. Service is for Cedar Point and Christian Island residents **ONLY**, as per identified household distribution list.
- Cottagers will have 48 hours to close cottages/leave as of Sunday October 11th, and be within BFN Territory no longer than October 13th, 2020.
- Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre. Walk-on passengers **MUST** wear mask for the duration of the trip. Captains have the discretion to deny passage if safety protocols are not followed.
- Indoor residential visits are permitted based on OPH recommendations: indoor social gatherings at **10** persons (including host), **25** outdoors
- Non-essential business(es) will continue to operate at 75%, following customer and employee safety protocols are posted for public notice.
- Outdoor recreation facilities will be open for use. This is limited to 10 people at a time, including supervising adults.
- Chief and Council may permit larger gatherings for the Recreation Centre and the Event Centre with appropriate social distancing guidelines.
- Funerals/weddings - Limited to immediate family only.
- Emergency Food Supply available to all Cedar Point and Christian Island households in isolation.
- Food Security available on a maintenance schedule to stock emergency supplies.
- Delivery companies restricted to those on the approved list as identified by the Emergency Operations Team.

Level 2 Minimal Restrictions

- Travel Restrictions: Unrestricted. **PASSENGER AND VEHICLE FARES IMPLEMENTED.**
- Conditional Agreement in place for non-resident members and immediate family visiting residents. All protocols currently in place must be followed.
- Chimnissing Transit resumes limited schedule with social and physical distancing protocols in place. Fares will be implemented.
- Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.
- Indoor residential visits are permitted based on OPH recommendations.
- Outdoor recreation facilities will be open for use. This is limited to 10 people at a time, including supervising adults.
- Non-essential business may open and operate at 50% capacity, following customer and employee safety protocols are posted for public notice.
- Chief and Council may permit larger gatherings such as outdoor commencement ceremonies for the Recreation Centre and the Event Centre with appropriate social distancing guidelines.
- Funerals - Limited to immediate family only.
- Mainland BFN members and immediate family (as per BFN P&P) are permitted to visit while following all safety recommendations.
- Masks are required in indoor settings with public interaction.
- Emergency Food Supply available to all Cedar Point and Christian Island households in isolation.
- Food Security available on a maintenance schedule to stock emergency supplies.
- Delivery companies restricted to those on the approved list as identified by the Emergency Operations Team.

Level 1 Lowest Restrictions

- Travel Restrictions: Unrestricted trips per week with regular ferry schedule.
- All cottagers, campers and non-residents are welcomed back.
- Hope and Beckwith open for camping and tourism.
- Chimnissing Transit resumes full schedule.
- Medical screening implemented for both ferry terminals, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.
- Masks are **recommended** in public spaces.
- Businesses are encouraged to post employee and customer safety protocols for public notices.
- Updates and ongoing communication to community.
