Re: Response Level Change, effective Sunday, October 11, 2020

Good Afternoon Chimnissing,

BFN developed and implemented the Covid-19 Response Plan in June 2020. In July 2020, it was recommended that the community move down from Level 3 to Level 2 with minimal restrictions. The EOT meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays and the situation at all levels is monitored. Currently, Fall is upon us and as cases rise within the province and a second wave declared, the Emergency Operations Team is recommending that we move to Level 3 of the response plan, with amendments.

Notable changes:

- No restriction on member travel (no household passes).
- BFN members and immediate family only (as per BFN P&P)
- Chimnissing Transit will only offer service to Cedar Point and Christian Island residents only, as per identified household distribution list.
- Cottagers will have 48 hours to close cottages/leave as of October 11th and be within BFN Territory no longer than October 13th, 2020.
- Boyfriends/girlfriends/fiancé/es will no longer be able to visit BFN territory.
- Ferry schedule & fare(s) remain the same (no changes).
- Non-essential business(es) will continue to operate at 75%.
- Masks are mandatory in ALL indoor settings.
- Indoor social gatherings at 10 persons (including host), 25 outdoors

We have lived in this pandemic for 7 months and we as a community have done well regarding the protection of our community and residents from Covid-19. The fight against the virus must continue and the focus of the EOT has shifted to implementing enhanced measures in prevention and safety for the community, to complement the Well-being Protocol approved last week.
