My background goes back to 1980 where I enlisted in the U.S. Marines serving five years Active Service then with the Marine Reserve component which in 1990-1991 our unit was mobilized for the Persian Gulf, Desert Storm-Shield Campaign. Upon discharge from the Military I then worked for various Criminal Justice positions. Corporate Security Officer with EDS (Electronic Data Systems), Federal Bureau of Prisons with USP Leavenworth Penitentiary, Detention and Treatment Facilities as a Child Care Worker, attended College acquiring an Associate's Degree; Major in Business and minor in Criminal Justice. Successfully completed the 45<sup>th</sup> Mid-Michigan

Police Academy. Upon return from Persian Gulf I was informed of a Police position available in my home Territory and was hired shortly thereafter. I enjoyed my initial Policing career which then had a change in a Regional Policing style that exists today as the Anishinabek Police Service. I also served the communities of Shawanaga, Wasauksing and Magnetawan first Nations for approximately 9 years prior to accepting the Sergeant role here in Christian Island First Nation. I currently have 24 years of service and hope to continue to make positive gains to improve our services to our Community to make it a better place for all to live and enjoy.
