About the Award

The Carl Monague Sr. Leadership award is for Beausoleil First Nation Youth in pursuit of post-secondary education, whether it be with an accredited University or College, training or apprenticeship program, internship, a program of part-time studies or any of a number of other educational endeavours. The intent of the award, which adheres to an expansive definition of "post secondary education", is intended to help a broad range of graduating secondary school students take the next steps towards their future through fulfilling their educational goals.

Eligibility

Beausoleil First Nation Youth, Grade 12 graduates entering post-secondary.

750 word essay on how they have demonstrated community involvement (either on or off reserve) while maintaining good grades at school.

Purpose of the Award

The Carl Monague Leadership Award is intended to support applicants who demonstrate the desire to achieve their educational goals. Applications will be assessed in accordance with established criteria.

Amount of the Award

Award valued at \$ 500.00, applicants are assessed individually.

Allocation of Award

Applications are reviewed by a Committee composed of three individuals: at least two Beausoleil First Nation members assigned to the committee by the Beausoleil Education Advisory Committee and an Education Department employee. After reviewing applications the Committee will choose a recipient.
