**i. Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA)**

The **community** will endeavour to have a responder equipped and ready to use an AED at the location of a patient determined to be in SCA within 6 minutes from the time ambulance dispatch conveys the call information to the paramedic **90 %** of the time.

**ii. CTAS 1**

The **ambulance service** will endeavour to have a paramedic or emergency medical attendant as defined by the Ambulance Act and duly equipped at the location of a patient determined to be CTAS 1 within 8 minutes from the time ambulance dispatch conveys the call information to the paramedic **90 %** of the time.


**iii. CTAS 2, 3, 4, 5**

The **ambulance service** will endeavour to have a paramedic or emergency medical attendant as defined by the Ambulance Act and duly equipped at the location of a patient determined to be CTAS 2, 3, 4, 5 within the amount of time specified in the table below. The percentage of time the target time will be achieved is also specified in the table below.

<b>CTAS</b>	<b>Target time*</b>	<b>% of target**</b>
2	8 minutes	75
3	15 minutes	75
4	30 minutes	85
5	30 minutes	90

\*Target time: the amount of time (minutes) from paramedic notification (T2) until on scene (T4)

\*\* % of target: percentage of time the target time will be achieved
