FIRST NATIONS CONSERVATION PROGRAM (FNCP)

ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

The objective of the First Nations Conservation Program is to help residential, on reserve customers with the following: reduce electricity consumption by making homes more energy efficient, improve homes' overall comfort, and build a culture of energy conservation.

The FNCP is designed specifically for on reserve homes or members residing in on-reserve band owned housing. This program provides community members living on-reserve, customized energy saving services and products. The FNCP is being offered to participating First Nation Communities across Ontario. It is completely voluntary and 100% free. Each customer works directly with an energy assessor, who recommends energy saving measures based on an assessment of their home. A Project Lead person is identified by the First Nation to assist homeowners with this program. A community helper* will accompany the assessor to ensure the customer feels at ease during the assessment.

- Assessment of lighting, appliance and water heating opportunities, and when restrictions have lifted due to COVID19, home insulation assessments and for those that qualify, insulation upgrades if time allows us to do so.

- Every home will receive no cost energy efficient product during the energy assessment.
