Job Title: **Mechanic/Welder**

Primary Duties:

- Generate and utilize logs to track maintenance of Beausoleil First Nation's fleet
- Communication and coordination between departments to schedule and plan maintenance
- Development of preventative maintenance practices
- Inspect and test mechanical units to locate faults and malfunctions
- Diagnose faults and malfunctions and confirm findings with supervisor to determine whether to repair or replace unit
- Repair or replace mechanical units or components
- Gather minimum three (3) quotes from potential suppliers as required
- Test and adjust units to specifications
- Complete reports to record problems and work performed
- Inspect motor in operation, road test motor vehicles and test automotive systems and components
- Adjust, repair or replace parts and components of automotive systems
- Test and adjust repaired systems to manufacturer's specifications
- Perform scheduled maintenance service
- Advise customers on work performed and future repair requirements
- Review work orders and discuss work with supervisor
- Perform routine safety inspections on heavy machinery prior to each shift
- Clean and make repairs on machinery as needed to ensure optimal functionality and safety
- Monitor machinery for needed replacements and make recommendations accordingly
- Adhere to all safety standards on various jobsites
- Adjust, repair or replace parts and components of truck-trailer systems
- Test and adjust repaired systems to manufacturer's specifications
