EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Beausoleil First Nation Child & Family Services is seeking a highly motivated and skilled individual to fill the following position. Preference will be given to people of Indigenous descent.

Job Title: Family Well-Being Worker

Description: The Family Well-Being Program has been designed to deliver prevention focused programming to improve the outcomes and opportunities for children, youth, and families. Support services focus on families impacted by family violence, intergenerational trauma and child welfare involvement by providing and utilizing resources to strengthen relationships within the home and community.

Primary Duties:

- o Increase access to support services and connect families to existing services that reflect the family wellness plan/needs.
- o Ensuring families are referred to appropriate supports and programs by assisting with goal-oriented and time-limited appointments
- o Case conferences with families, liaising and advocating on behalf of families
- o Transport clients to and from appointments, as necessary
- o Support the aim of increasing a sense of belonging through cultural awareness and activities
- o Work as a team with the Family Services staff, and the Social Services Dept.
- o Work closely by referrals from Band Representatives to develop, implement, and monitor case management plans, providing regular follow-up and support to families ensuring continued progress & success
- o Assist with the successful implementation of Family Well-Being primary objectives, such as the creation of community "Safe Spaces," and family violence prevention strategies
- o Liaise with and strengthen our internal partnerships with the Education Dept. And Health Dept., in order to better serve and advocate for clientele
- o Network and liaison professionally with community agencies and resources, in order to promote and increase the community's overall health & well-being

Qualifications:

- o Social Services Diploma/Degree or equivalent, and a minimum of 1-2 years' experience in a related field or more.
- o Relevant combination of education and related experience and knowledge will also be considered
- o Indigenous ancestry preferred with working knowledge of Anishnaabe culture, traditions, and language
- o Must be prepared for flexible work schedule.
- o Valid driver's license
- o Reliable vehicle
- o Current vulnerable police sector check (VSS) required within two weeks minimum of employment offer
- o Must be willing to attain further training and/or certification in Child Welfare

Salary Range: DOQ/DOE, to be negotiated according to Family Service's salary grid

Duration: Full-time Permanent, subject to 89-day probation period
