The Beausoleil First Nation is seeking to hire an individual to fill Ferry Deckhand position aboard the M.V. Sandy Graham and the Indian Maiden. **Preference will be given to applicants who are of Aboriginal Descent, Speak or have knowledge of the local First Nation Language and due to the evening mooring of the Vessels-must reside within the Beausoleil First Nation Community.**

Job Title: FERRY DECKHAND X2 Positions

Qualifications: 1. The following certification will be considered an asset and reflected in the total score of interview. **Must be willing to train on the job.**

- ▶ Restricted Radio Operator's Certificate re: VHF radiotelephone an asset
- ▶ STCW BASIC SAFETY, STCW PSC OR MED A1, B1, B2, MED II, an asset
- ▶ Valid Marine BASIC First Aid an asset
- ▶ Valid CPR with AED endorsement an asset
- ▶ Undertake and obtain a "FIT" Marine Medical Certificate to remain eligible for permanent employment

2. 1 to 2 years experience as a member of the deck crew preferred but not required. Relief work on either vessel also an asset.

3. Strong commitment to the health and safety of the passengers, crew and ship

4. Able to meet Beausoleil First Nation's COVID 19 vaccination policy requirements prior to employment
