### **RULES AND REGULATIONS – COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN – LESSEES**

The hours of operation for our processing centre are from **8:15 AM – 7:45 PM DAILY**. Should you arrive outside this timeframe you will NOT be permitted access to the Sandy Graham.

#### **When you arrive;**

- ✓ Ensure you are wearing a mask at ALL times during processing.
- ✓ You are to remain in your vehicles at ALL times before boarding and while on board the Sandy Graham.
- ✓ Medical Screening will be implemented at the processing centre, as mandated by Transport Canada and Beausoleil Family Health Centre.
- ✓ Transport Canada regulations allow for 5 passengers per vehicle. Passenger limits mean that walk-ons are NOT permitted.
- ✓ One family, one vehicle a day
- ✓ SINE application/ should sign in along and complete Health screening, screeners/security for our seasonal visitors will be checking in passengers

#### **During your stay;**

- ✓ Trailers, motor homes, boats, seadoos, will be permitted but during off peak days and hours, preferably Sunday to Wednesday
- ✓ All trails and beaches and are OFF-LIMITS with the exception of Big Sand Bay. If you have a cottage within that subdivision, the beach areas are available for your use. Please note that although our beaches are closed to the public, **BFN members** have been PERMITTED use of **ALL** beaches. Please keep social distancing rules in mind. The beach by-law remains in effect and will be enforced.
- ✓ Lessees are **NOT permitted to travel to the island using their OWN boats during the schedule**. We must be able to process all lessees at our processing centre at Cedar Point and to check names against our manifest of approved visitors.
- ✓ As much as you may wish to see Islander friends and Islander friends would like to see you, we strongly DISCOURAGE visitations with Island residents (and vice versa) for the duration of the schedule. Christian Island residence will be reminded of the social distancing protocols and measures in place and that our seasonal non-residents are subject to Level 3 and 4 restrictions.
- ✓ Fines may be issued for non-compliance.

- ✓ Anyone found in contravention of the rules, will be asked to leave immediately

### **Home Maintenance;**

- ✓ For contracted services (ie. renovations, yard work, maintenance etc.) we encourage you to ensure that ANY work being done is done when you are OFF-ISLAND and if this is not possible, we encourage you to practice safe-distancing and other measures. Contractors will also be reminded of the social distancing protocols and measures in place and must have appropriate PPE on hand at all times.

### **Waste Pick Up;**

- ✓ Waste and recycling services will resume upon your arrival. Please use the bins and bags provided.

### **Administrative Purposes;**

- ✓ For the duration of the schedule identified above, Lessees will be able to attend any place of business within the community and must follow all provincial safety protocols.
- ✓ The Administration Building is open and staffing is at 100% We ask all non-residents to CALL in to the office rather than attend in person for duration of the schedule identified above.
- ✓ With the exception of businesses operating under capacity restrictions, indoor gatherings of more than 25 people are prohibited.

Should a case of COVID-19 present itself within the community, Christian Island will be subjected to a **Level 6** of the Beausoleil First Nation Response Plan. This means all travel to and from Christian Island will be restricted. **All non-residents (including cottagers) will be provided 48 hours to vacate the island. This will be an emergency order. Please be ready at all times should an emergency shut-down occur.**
