(LIGHTHOUSE AND BIG SAND BAY SUBDIVISION, MONAGUE POINT AND SANDY SUBDIVISION)

RE: 2021 Cottage Season Closing

Chief and Council would like to remind all lessees that we are still under a State of Emergency (due to COVID) and this has not been lifted since it was declared on March 16, 2020. As such, the rules that were put in place to identify and limit visitors to our island during the pandemic will continue to remain in effect and we once again ask for your patience and understanding during this time.

To be clear, the directed shut-down of the cottage season has everything to do with Covid and to protect the best interests of the year-round residents. Be advised that once the situation is under control, access to your cottage lots will once again be provided. The Lands Department will ensure to provide notification well in advance of the cottage season opening in 2022 about further (or continued) restrictions that may or may not be in place.

The Lands Department has been tasked to coordinate the closing date for the cottage season and Council fully supports their efforts. Please adhere to the rules. Ensure that the preparations that you need to make in order to close your cottage will be completed by no later than October 12, 2021. (This is amended from the earlier notice to allow for added traffic leaving the island). Emergency requests for access beyond this date (to address damages due to fire, flood, natural disasters, break-ins) may be considered on a case-by-case basis. Should you require access to your cottage outside of the closing date, please send your requests to Dana Monague or Crystal Roote, A/Co-Managers of the Lands Department. All other requests (for non-emergent reasons) will not be considered at this time. Until 2022, stay safe and we look forward to seeing you again.
