

SIXTIES SCOOP SETTLEMENT **(the “Sixties Scoop”).**

What was the Sixties Scoop?

Between 1951 and 1991, Indian and Inuit children were taken into care and placed with non-Indigenous parents where they were not raised in accordance with their cultural traditions nor taught their traditional languages

Who is Included in the settlement?

The settlement includes people who:

- are registered Indians (as defined in the Indian Act) and Inuit as well as people eligible to be registered Indians; and
- were removed from their homes in Canada between January 1, 1951 and December 31, 1991 and placed in the care of non-Indigenous foster or adoptive parents
