The Beausoleil First Nation Transportation Department is seeking to hire one individual for the position of Relief Captain aboard the M.V. Sandy Graham, the Indian Maiden and Waaseyaagmik. The Casual Relief Captain will be responsible for the overall on-board management of crew and passengers, and overall control of all vessels utilized to provide Transportation Service. Preference will be given to applicants who are of Indigenous Descent.
