The Beausoleil First Nation Transportation Department is seeking to hire one individual for the position of First Mate aboard the M.V. Sandy Graham, the Indian Maiden & Waaseyaagmik. The First Mate will be responsible to assist the Master in the overall control of the vessels and other Transportation Services. The First Mate will act as Master in the absence of the Master or as requested by the Master. Preference will be given to applicants who are of Indigenous descent.

Job Title: **Casual Relief for First Mate**

Qualifications: Must hold the following certifications

- Limited Mates Ticket for a Short Run
- Radio Operator's Certificate re: VHF, Canadian Coast Guard and Base
- MED II: Rowing of Ship's Lifeboats; the wearing of Breathing Apparatus in smoke-filled areas and the Hauling of Pressurized Hoses; the up righting of overturned life rafts while wearing life jackets and/or immersion suits and immersed in water; Other related Marine Emergency Duty Activities
- Valid First Aid Certificate
- CPR would be an asset
- One to three years' experience as a member of a deck crew required
- Solid knowledge base and proficiency in Marine Navigation
- Experience and demonstrated ability to provide flexible and competent leadership and supervision in a team atmosphere
- Excellent public relations skills

- Ability to guide vessels in rivers, canals, and other confined or hazardous waters and waterways
