## DISPOSAL OF HUNTING REMAINS WITHIN BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION TERRITORY

Christian Island, Ontario/ November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 – Beausoleil First Nation Lands & Resources staff responded to a call from a member regarding animal remains being disposed on Zhimaagnish Miikaans.

As First Nations people we all must remember our responsibilities to all living beings, life and creation. Our ancestors have always shown immense care for all life and creation; in turn we must follow the lead set out by those that came before us. It has always been our culture and tradition to ensure that any life that is taken from creation is used in the most sustainable way, through humaine methods of hunting, ceremonial offerings and minimal waste

We would like to advise and request that any of our members who are hunting, fishing, gathering and foraging, are ensuring they are properly disposing of any remains not being sustainably used. Any remains are not to be disposed of in the following areas:

- Village and Community areas;
- Cottage subdivisions;
  - Big Sand Bay Subdivision;
  - Lighthouse Subdivision;
  - Monague Subdivision;
  - Sandy Subdivision;
- Private property (lands held through Evidence of Title or Certificate of Possession).

To request disposal on lands held by the First Nation contact our office. For reference the attached map identifies areas of land held by the First Nation (highlighted yellow and outlined in blue) and lands held through an Evidence of Title or Certificate of Possession (highlighted in orange).
