


ROSTER PANELISTS


Beausoleil First Nation is looking for interested and qualified members to sit on the Dispute Resolution Roster Panel. The panel is established to resolve disputes in relation to Beausoleil First Nation land (except for disputes under L.C. Sec. 42.5). The panelists shall represent various elements of the community.

Roster panel eligibility Eligible Criteria:

- 1. a member of Beausoleil First Nation;
- 2. be of legal age majority; eighteen (18) years;
- 3. possess the ability to act impartially and without bias or favor;



- ·member of Council, or the Chief;
- ·employee of Beausoleil First Nation;
- member of the Land Code Committee;



Members sitting on the Roster panel will be responsible to: Hold dispute hearings, confirm, reverse or substitute a decision pertaining to a dispute filed and direct actions be taken or ceased, make an order to give effect to a decision, make recommendations to council under L.C. Sec. 46.2 or any other recommendations deemed appropriate by Council.

Honorarium

Members that sit on the Roster panel will receive an honorarium set out by Council.

Liability Release

Roster panelists are not liable for their service in connection to the dispute resolution process (except in cases that involve fraud and misconduct.)
