WE, THE COUNCIL OF BEAUSOLEIL FIRST NATION, DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

WHEREAS, Beausoleil First Nation is currently experiencing an extreme weather event, in relation to the freezing rain over the past 24 hours, which has resulted in significant threats to public safety, infrastructure, and essential services; and

WHEREAS, the severity of this weather event has caused, widespread power outages, road closures, destruction of property, risk to human life, thereby endangering the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Beausoleil First Nation; and

WHEREAS, local emergency response resources have been deployed to address the crisis, but additional support and coordination are necessary to effectively manage the disaster, provide aid to affected individuals, and mitigate further damage; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Beausoleil First Nation’s Emergency Response Plan, Chief & Council has the authority to declare a state of emergency to activate emergency response measures and secure additional resources for disaster relief and recovery;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief and Council of Beausoleil First Nation declares a STATE OF EMERGENCY effective immediately; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this declaration authorizes the activation of emergency response plans, the allocation of necessary funds, the mobilization of public safety personnel and equipment, and coordination with provincial and federal governments to ensure the protection of lives and property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this emergency declaration shall remain in effect until such time as the extreme weather event and its immediate consequences have been sufficiently addressed, as determined by the appropriate authorities; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all residents of Beausoleil First Nation are urged to follow official emergency instructions, cooperate with public safety personnel, and take all necessary precautions to ensure their safety and well-being.
