The Professional Instructor in Driver Education (P.R.I.D.E.) Program is a joint venture of the Ontario Motor Coach Association (OMCA), Ontario Public Transit Association (OPTA) and School Bus Ontario (SBO). This one-of-a-kind program teaches fleet driver instructors how to properly train new and seasoned drivers. If a passing grade is achieved, a certificate is issued, thus providing one of the prerequisites for "Signing Authority" under the Ontario Ministry of Transportation's "Driver Certification Program".

Requirements:

- Be at least 21 years old.
- Hold a valid Ontario drivers license other than class G1, G2, M, M1, or M2.
- Have less than 6 demerit points on their driving record.
- Not have been suspended during the previous 12 months for: Driving under suspension, Speeding over 50 km/hr over the limit, Careless driving or racing on a highway, Leaving the scene of an accident.
- Any Criminal Code of Canada committed by means of a motor vehicle or while driving or having care and control of a motor vehicle.
