

Severe Weather Event Update #2 For Beausoleil First Nation

Estimated Power Restoration:

As indicated by the Hydro One Storm Centre, the **UPDATED** estimated time for power restoration for Beausoleil First Nation is listed for 8 PM on April 1st.



Warming Centre:

The Christian Island Elementary School and Beausoleil Day Care Centre have been set up as warming centres in lieu of the Recreation Centre not having power. Emergency power has been re-established at the Recreation Centre and will now serve as the warming centre. Shower facilities are also available at the Recreation Centre.

Community Meal:

A community meal is being prepared and will be available for those who wish to drop in at the Recreation Centre around 6 PM.

Community Transportation

Should you require transportation to the warming centre or to drop in for the community meal, please contact the Paramedic Duty Officer at 705-796-1666. The Paramedics will assist those who need transportation.

Emergency Power Supply

Parks and Tourism staff continue to provide fuel top ups to those who require diesel under the Emergency Power Supply project.

Emergency Food Supply

Arrangements are being made with Brian's Food Basket to distribute a fruit/vegetable hamper on Tuesday (April 1st) morning at 11 AM. The hamper will be available for pick up at the Recreation Centre.

Emergency Fuel Supply

We have acquired some gasoline to be able to provide to vulnerable populations who are not on the Emergency Power Supply Project; this includes Seniors, those who are disabled, and parents with small children. Once those needs for those populations have been addressed, we will continue to support the rest of the community. Please reach out to 705-247-2122 if you require assistance.

Wellness Checks

Wellness checks continue to be completed by BFN staff (Health Dept, Paramedics, Social Services, and Security) on Christian Island and at Cedar Point.
